1. Child Support Forms

- a. **Motion to Change Support Order** – use this form if you would like to seek modification of your support obligation

- c. **Motion to Rescind License Suspension and Notice of Hearing** – Use these forms if you would like to schedule a hearing to ask the court to reinstate a license suspended because of support arrearages

3. Opting-out of Friend of the Court Services

- a. **Advise of Rights Form**-Read this form for information regarding opting-out of Friend of the Court services. Both parties must sign this form and return it to the Friend of the Court. Your file must satisfy all the listed criteria. Before parents can opt-out they must file a motion, schedule it for hearing and obtain an order from the Court. If you have

questions on how to proceed you will need to consult an attorney as the Friend of the Court cannot give legal advice.

- b. **Motion**- Use this form if you wish to opt-out. Attach a copy of the Advise of Rights Form for the Court
