

## ENFORCEMENT OF PARENTING TIME

The Friend of the Court can enforce parenting time (visitation) that has been ordered by the Court. The schedule of parenting time in the order provides the basic rules on how parenting time is to occur. When the rules are not followed by one of the parents, if the other parent would like to seek enforcement they must file a written complaint with the office. The Friend of the Court cannot take enforcement action on oral arrangements made between the parents. Additionally, the office cannot take enforcement action on parent/child related issues like curfew violations, haircuts, homework or school problems etc. These types of issues along with joint legal custody problems must be resolved between the parents and if no resolution is reached the parent would have to seek redress by petitioning the Court.

The Friend of the Court has a detailed procedure regarding the enforcement of parenting time. Parents should take a moment to review the procedure in detail before proceeding with a complaint.
