#### **Manager monthly report**

Long Lake campground manager Patrick presented the monthly report for discussion:

Boat launch: Is currently still being worked on.

Fence outside house: Was ordered waiting on arrival and pick up.

New water front lots: Were all graveled

New Truck: Spoke about maybe getting a new truck as the current one has a hole in the floor board.

Play set net: Noticed a net is broken on the bridge part, need to figure out the brand and where to order a new net.

Fishing dock repair: Just finished repair of broken one and will be finishing up some new decking on another.

#### **Old Business:**

Camp hosts names: Dennis Moldenhouer, Shane and Ernie. Briefly chatted about Having availability of another. Have no one in mind at this time.

2025 youth and rec grant: Youth board will visit in July, Aug 1<sup>st</sup> at 6pm presentation about the plan.

Status of current park truck: Needs Oil change, floor is rotted, needs new tires, needs new plugs and wires. - Jesse is looking into getting the floor fixed.

Status of getting new truck: Is unlikely to happen this year due to Sunken Lake house and not having money in the budget to make so many large purchases.


Status of waterfront sites: All graveled and power and water is all set.

Status of old bathhouse: Have no water pressure. Pure Water Well came out and tried to fix it. May need new tanks? Unsure at this time.

Store hours and phone number?: Currently no posted hours however when Patrick is working in park his number is posted so people can call should they want to get in the store. Marissa is in the store for a couple hours when she gets out of work in the evenings, most days.
