

## **Alpena Huron Shore Little League**

Project: Alpena Huron Shore Complex Field Renovations

Grant: \$20,000.00

Alpena Huron Shore Little League provides an opportunity for area youth to participate in little league baseball, softball and t-ball programs. They currently maintain eighteen fields in Alpena County for games, practices and tournaments. The grant monies awarded were to improve four infields at the main complex. Specialized resurfacing materials were put on the infields of Sabourin, Rohn, Reynolds and Sobeck fields to help eliminate the safety risks for players and to improve the quality of ballgames. Improvements to these fields are expected to last between 15-20 years and approximately 750-800 area players will benefit from this project.
